## **CHALLENGES**

- Managing approximately 80 insurance policies across 200+ legal entities globally
- Consolidating insurance information from multiple brokers for a \$4.5 billion company
- Producing accurate summaries of insurance quickly, often requested a dozen times per year
- Keeping up with increasingly complex underwriting requirements and policy types
- Operating as a one-person risk management team for a large, multinational corporation

## RESULTS

- Saved at least one full-time employee (FTE) position, valued at \$150,000+ per year
- **Dramatically reduced time spent** on manual data entry and report generation
- Improved accuracy and **consistency** of insurance information across the organization
- **Enhanced collaboration** with legal and accounting teams by quickly answering inquiries and providing them direct access to relevant insurance data
